DIY Punched Paper Vases

If you are looking for creative, yet inexpensive, vases that tie in with your color theme while still allowing your flowers to take center stage, look no further than these simple DIY paper wraps. Made of simple cardstock and wrapped around mismatched vases, these can be tailored to fit to any height or width. Try using different punches to experiment with patterns!

Supplies needed:

- Vases or mason jars in various heights and sizes
- Colored cardstock
- Paper border punches (available at Michael's or other craft stores)
- Clear tape or ZOTS

1. On a clean surface, lay out paper to be used and punch borders with border punch. Experiment by punching one or both ends of the paper for variety.



2. Holding the paper in place, wrap tightly around vase and tape closed, or use ZOTS if you are concerned about the tape being visible.



3. Fill vases with water and flowers, and place on table!
